The four major goals of the Credential Program are to: (1) Help develop a professional workforce qualified to provide care for young learners (2) Improve your status and compensation (3) Recognize your professional learning and ongoing education toward new innovations in child care and early learning (4) Give you a structure for growth. > Director's Specialization -- Family Child Care Specialization -- Infant/Toddler Specialization The Pre-School Specialization and Out of School Time Specialization are still being developed.

July - August - September Training Descriptions

Creating An Autism Friendly Classroom - CG&D - Environment & Curriculum; - Basic Level -- Melissa Cuppett

This training is for early childhood educators seeking information on creating an autism friendly classroom through the use of visual schedules, social stories, calm down corners and more. This training was created for educators working with children in preschool/ pre-k/school age classrooms.

Hooray for Outdoor Play! - CG&D - Basic Level -- Chris Gillis

This training will focus on the benefits of outdoor play for young children. We will discuss strategies to support and challenge, using age and developmentally appropriate practices. This online training is geared for childcare providers working with children ages 3-5 years old.

Include Me! A Guide to Inclusive Child Care - CG&D - Environment & Curriculum - Basic Level -- Linda Reeves

Early care and education programs provide a playful and natural environment for all children to grow and develop. The opportunity for children with disabilities to participate in these experiences with other young children has great value. This training will focus on an overview of young children with disabilities, what inclusion in early care and education looks like, benefits of inclusion, working with specialists, and examples of inclusive early care and education strategies. This training is for anyone working with children birth - 6 years in childcare settings.

Learning to Guide Challenging Behavior - Environment & Curriculum; - Basic Level -- Melissa Cuppett

This online training was developed to help early childhood educators assess various situations and behaviors occurring in the classroom and how to redirect or eliminate challenging behaviors by communicating with families and building on the positive qualities of the child.

Natural vs Logical Consequences - Environment & Curriculum; - Basic Level -- Melissa Cuppett

This is an online training is for early childhood educators wanting to better understand the differences between logical and natural consequences and how to use them in a child care setting.

RR Spreading HOPE- CG&D - Family & Community Partnerships - Intermediate Level -- Linda Reeves 🎎

The Spreading HOPE training will cover the effects of ACEs on health outcomes, the importance of positive childhood experiences, and the research showing their mitigating effects on ACEs as well as the biological basis for these effects. We will introduce the four building blocks of HOPE and discuss type 1 vs. type 2 thinking. The presentation will present some ideas of how to incorporate the

Understanding ACEs 101 - CG&D - Basic Level -- Linda Reeves



Adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) are potentially traumatic events that occur before a child reaches the age of 18. Such experiences can interfere with a person's health, opportunities, and stability throughout his or her lifetime. The Understanding ACEs 101 training will discuss ACEs and their impact on children and adults, introduce ways to overcome ACEs through resilience, and introduce strategies to prevent ACEs by shedding light on potential risk factors.



HOPE Framework into practice.

WV Early Learning Standards Framework: Infant/Toddler with Lesson Planning Face to Face/In Person Training -- CCRC Fairmont Office



This is a six-hour module series, broken up into 3, 2-hour classes. This course will provide an opportunity to explore the WV Early Learning Standards Framework for Infants & Toddlers by focusing on two developmental domains each class. Each class will discuss the purpose, content, application and benefits of the learning standards, as well as, how to incorporate each domain into a lesson plan. By the end of the module series, you will have a detailed explanation of how the early learning stands work and how to incorporate them into a complete lesson plan for infants and toddlers. Upon completion you will be eligible for resources directly linked to the WVELSF for Infants and Toddlers.

The Growing Brain Module Training – In Person CCRC Morgantown Office

This innovative training focuses on giving trainers evidenceinformed strategies with which to prepare early childhood providers for their vital role in building healthy brains. The curriculum fills a unique niche by providing a comprehensive

understanding of how the brain develops, along with ways the provider can encourage healthy brain development in children from birth to 5 years old.

Participants will learn skills and strategies for:

- 1. Teaching early childhood providers about brain development (architecture and neurobiology) to inform their practice.
- 2. Supporting language, cognition, prosocial behavior, and social-emotional development.
- 3. Reducing toxic stress that can negatively influence brain development of very young children.

The Growing Brain: From Birth to 5 Years Old is comprised of seven 3-hour units.

Unit 2: Factors Affecting Brain Growth and Development

Unit 3: Communication and Language Development


